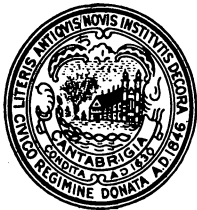

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$1,679.30 to reimburse William Costello, an employee of the Public Works Department for damages in this amount.

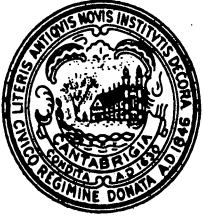
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against William Costello in which there was a judgment of \$1,679.30.


To the Honorable, the City Council,
