Fr. Tobin was educated at St. Paul's Elementary School and Cambridge High and Latin School, graduating in 1947 after having served our country during World War II in the United States Coast Guard; and

WHEREAS:

Fr. Tobin studied for the Priesthood at the Holy Cross Fathers Seminary at North Easton at Stonehill College and North Dartmouth at the Holy Cross Novitiate as well as at the Gregorian University, Rome, Italy; and

WHEREAS:

Fr. Tobin was ordained into the Priesthood on October 30, 1955 in the Church of the Holy Apostles in Rome; and

WHEREAS:

During Fr. Tobin's priestly ministry he has taught at the secondary school level in New York, became the Director of Vocations for the Holy Cross Fathers, has preached at retreats and missions throughout the United States and Canada and since 1973 has been the Superior of the Holy Cross Fathers Mission House and Band; now therefore be it
