- WHEREAS: After graduating from Somerville High School, Leo worked as a truck driver with his brothers Julius and Eugene; and
- WHEREAS: Leo served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II; he served in the Phillipine Islands, was wounded twice and was awarded a Bronze Star and two Purple Hearts; and
- WHEREAS: On June 16, 1946, at St. Francis of Assisi Church in Cambridge, Leo joined his heart, hand and life in Holy Matrimony to Anna (Scolles); and
- WHEREAS: The marriage of Leo and Anna was blessed with four fine children, Nancy, Nicholas, Leo Joseph, Jr. and David; as the children grew up and Linda married Nicholas, Leo married Ruth and David married Doreen, Anna and Leo became the proud grandparents of Nicolas, Amee, Ericha, Jennifer, Lori, Leo J., Kimberly and Paige; and
- WHEREAS: Leo worked for the City of Cambridge as a painter; and
- WHEREAS: Leo loved music and painting and, most of all, his family; and
- WHEREAS: Leo passed away on July 31, 1967; and
- WHEREAS: Leo served his nation bravely in World War II and he served the citizens of Cambridge faithfully as an employee of the City of Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record dedicating the corner of Sciarrapa Street and Winter Street as:

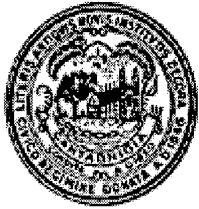
