
To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am pleased to inform you that I have appointed the following individuals to the North Massachusetts Avenue Conservation District Study Committee. Chapter 2.78 of the Cambridge Municipal Code requires that the Study Committee contain seven members: three members or alternates of the Historical Commission; at least one person who owns property in the proposed district; at least one person who lives in the proposed district; and at least one person who owns property or resides elsewhere in the City and has demonstrated knowledge and concern for architectural preservation.
