Ordered,

That the street in Ward Five, heretofore known as Willow Street, be accepted and laid out as a public highway by the name of Loved Street, forty feet in width, from North Avenue to the Somerville line, as the same is delineated in a Plan by W. A. Cleasby, dated Aug. 1866, and now before this Board.

Ordered, That no damages be awarded to any person for land taken in the laying out of said street.
