ORDERED:-

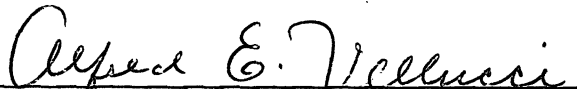
That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge do hereby proclaim February 1, 1971 as
