- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that on April 26, 1979 the East Cambridge Boys Club has chosen John F. Clinton, former Chairman and member of the Cambridge Housing Authority as their "Man of the Year"; and
- WHEREAS: John Clinton is a lifelong resident of Cambridge, who has been extremely active in both civic and fraternal organizations throughout his life; and
- WHEREAS: Among John Clinton's many activities he served as a member of the Employee Committee for Polaroid Corporation, he was a former Shop Steward and Chairman of Recreation for the Auto Workers Local #901 as well as Executive Board Member, Shop Steward and Secretary for Local #25 of the United Rubber Workers; and
- WHEREAS: John's civic responsibilities are numerous and far reaching among those are his membership on the Committee on Elders, the Home Improvement Program Advisory Committee of the Wellington-Harrington Citizens Committee, the Democratic Ward and City Committee representing Ward Two, Clerk for the Boxing Committee of the New England Amateur Athletic Union, a position he held for fifteen years, former Vice-President and Executive Committee member of the Cambridge Economic Opportunity Committee, Chairman of the Model Cities Board of Directors and former Chairman and member of the Cambridge Housing Authority; and
- WHEREAS: While John served as a Commissioner on the Housing Authority he devoted his full energies to ensuring as many Cantabrigians as possible were provided safe and decent housing as well as taking a special interest in the needs of the elderly and encouraged and supported the construction of elderly housing units; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our most sincere appreciation to John F. Clinton for his sincerity, dedication and continuous advice, support and guidance throughout the years; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation to John F. Clinton a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution.
