ASCOM AUTELCA COMMUNICATIONS, LTD.

Ascom Autelca Communications, Ltd. ("Ascom") seeks to provide alternative operator services ("AOS") and resold transmission services within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Ascom would provide 1+ long-distance service and AOS, via a live operator or automated attendant equipment, on an interLATA and intraLATA basis from privately-owned pay telephones ("COCOTs") and locations within the hospitality industry, such as hotels and motels. Ascom would also provide interLATA 1+ services on a coin-sent-paid basis from COCOTs. Ascom would be providing these services through a contractual agreement with Sprint Services, a division of United Telecom.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Application of Ascom Autelca Communications, Ltd. to the Department of Public Utilities, under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added, or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing on the above matter at its hearing room, Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts on January 8, 1991 at 10:00 a.m.

The Applicant, Ascom Autelca Communications, Ltd., is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once, at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe, The Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Gazette (Pittsfield), and The Evening Gazette (Worcester), and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date on the attached list, and to make a return of service and publication, to include original clippings of the newspaper publications, at the time of the hearing.
