CHARTER RIGHT CONTINUED

7. A Charter Right was exercised by Councillor Danehy on a communication from the City Manager, in response to Awaiting Report Item No. 3, regarding the implementation of a policy on AIDS for City personnel.
8. A Charter Right was exercised by Councillor Danehy on a communication from the City Manager, relative to the authorization of a transfer from available balance from previous sewer projects of \$750,000. to fund the design of Phase VI and VII of the City's Sanitary Sewerage and Storm Drainage program, covering the Agassiz area, including Oxford/Kirkland/Plympton, and the Mass./Rindge/Concord Avenue area.
9. A Charter Right was exercised by Councillor Danehy on a communication from the City Manager, enclosing a letter from James F. O'Leary, General Manager of the M.B.T.A., outlining procedures used to determine the need for bus shelters.
10. A Charter Right was exercised by Councillor Danehy on a communication from the City Manager, relative to notification from Michael Greene of his resignation as Administrator of the Cambridge Hospital, and the appointment of John G. O'Brien as Interim Acting Administrator.
11. A Charter Right was exercised by Councillor Danehy on a communication from the City Manager, relative to the appointment of Ms. Sarah Wunsch of 4 Oakdale Street, Jamaica Plain, as Executive Director of the Cambridge Human Rights Commission.
12. A Charter Right was exercised by Councillor Danehy on a communication from the City Manager, requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Executive Office of Community Development of \$14,750. to the Community Development Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to provide funds for the complete weatherization of ten additional low-income homes.
13. A Charter Right was exercised by Councillor Danehy on a communication from the City Manager, relative to the transfer of \$12,500. from the Public Works Salaries and Wages Account to the Public Works Travel and Training Account to provide funds for a lump sum settlement.
