That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to appoint a Cable TV Committee which is to be made up of eleven members which would include the following:

1. Eight of whom shall be from community groups, people of color, elderly, youth, education and human services.
2. Two of whom shall be individuals with expert knowledge relating to cable TV.
3. One of whom shall serve as an ex-official member responsible for coordinating the city's cable effort.
4. The Committee would be empowered to hold public meetings, recommend policy with the City Council being advised of all developments by the ex-officio of the City Council.
