NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

On May 27, 1986, pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, sec. 2, the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") adopted, under its emergency powers, federal regulations 49 CFR 171.812, dealing with the transportation by rail of hazardous materials.

These new regulations are issued pursuant to, and by direction of, G.L. c. 25, sec. 5C added by Chapter 674 of the acts of 1985.

The Department will hold a public hearing on August 15, 1986, at 10:00 A.M. at the Department's offices, 100 Cambridge Street, 12th Floor, Boston, Massachusetts to determine whether the regulations issued on May 27, 1986 should be adopted on a permanent basis. A copy of the Department's Order dated May 27, 1986 is available from the Secretary, Department Of Public Utilities, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02202.

Oral comments relating to the proposal may be submitted by any interested person at the public hearing.

All parties interested in submitting written comments must do so no later 5:00 P.M., August 25, 1986, to the Secretary of the Department of Public Utilities, at the above address.
