- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the death of Robert G. Delaney, former Cambridge police officer and long time Cambridge resident; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Delaney was born in Beverly and raised in Hyde Park where he attended Hyde Park High School before moving to Cambridge at the age of seventeen; and
- WHEREAS: After completing high school, Mr. Delaney joined Local No.4 of the Operating Engineers Union where he worked until his Country called him to serve in the U.S. Navy during World War II; and
- WHEREAS: Upon completion of duty in the Navy, Mr. Delaney was appointed to the Cambridge Police Department and assigned to the Motorcycle unit of said department and served until a motorcycle accident forced his retirement in 1947; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Delaney returned to the construction industry as an operating engineer and by 1963 was named business manager of Local No. 4; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Delaney, during a construction project collapse on January 25, 1971, risked his own life helping more than 40 men escape from this accident; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Delaney was the recipient of a citation from then President Richard M. Nixon and an award from the American Legion for his heroic efforts in 1971; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathies to Mr. Delaney's daughters, Kathleen Delaney and Claire Murphy at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Delaney Family on behalf of the entire City Council.
