WHEREAS: This information will sensitize our teachers and workers to better comprehend other cultures upon return to Cambridge schools; and

WHEREAS: The delegation will be sent off by an evening of elementary school children's performances on April 3, and a Rock 'n Roll Sock Hop on April 5, both to be held at the First Parish Church on Church Street; and

WHEREAS: These events will also have the larger focus of honoring our city's relationship with our sister city San Jose Las Flores in El Salvador; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council wishes all participants a safe and productive trip to San Jose Las Flores; and further be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council sends its greetings to the government, schools, and people of El Salvador with a special hello to San Jose Las Flores; and further be it

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation on April 3.
