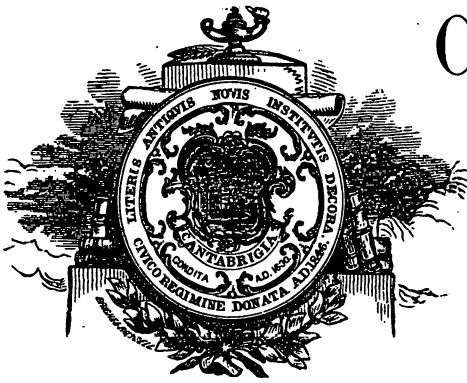




# CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.
