WHEREAS: Neighborhoods in West Cambridge are experiencing an influx of young families which include a great number of young children, and

WHEREAS: For the last few years traffic on the side streets has increased and automobiles speed through without regard for the safety of these new youngsters in the area, Therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager direct the Traffic Department to post necessary signs; repaint crossing markings; make sure that Crossing Guards for neighborhood schools are in as many intersections as necessary; and further direct the Traffic and Police Department to provide necessary enforcement in the area of Huron Avenue, Lexington Avenue, Lakeview Avenue, Standish Street, Chilton Street, Fayerweather Street, and in the vicinity of the Tobin, St. Peter's and the Fayerweather School, and the business district of Huron and Concord Avenue to ensure the safety of the children, both of school age and pre-school age.
