matter of said encroachments.

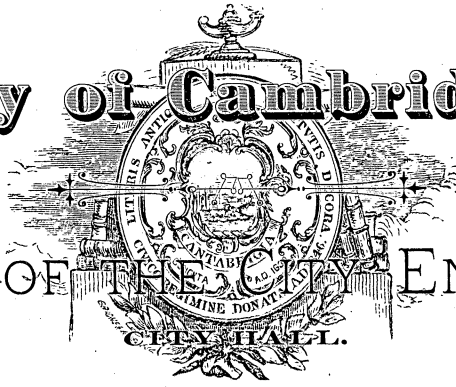

To the Hon the Mayor & Aldermen
Gentlemen

The undersigned respectfully represents that Alexander Dickinson, has, (in the construction of a new block of buildings bounded by Broadway, Market and Clark Streets,) caused the steps to be placed as follows;

In Broadway from $1\frac{1}{8}$ inches to $2\frac{3}{4}$ inches

In Market Street from $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches to $3\frac{1}{4}$ inches

In Clark Street from $1\frac{1}{8}$ inches to $2\frac{1}{8}$ inches

All the said bricks having been furnished to the said Dickinson previous to erecting the same
