- WHEREAS: Residents of the streets which cross Huron Avenue are greatly concerned about the safety of pedestrians trying to cross Huron Avenue, especially young children; and
- WHEREAS: It is virtually impossible for the Police to enforce the speed laws at all times; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the Traffic Department to install "Pedestrian Crossing" street stanchions in the center of the street similar to those used by the town of Arlington on Massachusetts Avenue and report back to this City Council in two weeks regarding these signs.
