COUNCILLOR WYLIE

WHEREAS: That increased numbers of contractors, utilities, and agencies are excavating in Cambridge streets and sidewalks and dangerous conditions are often created; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager is requested to cause the Police Department and the Department of Public Works to:-

1. prepare a stringent, detailed set of standards and regulations, with severe penalties to govern the blockading, lighting, signage, detouring and other matters related to such excavating;
2. mail such standards and regulations to all persons permitted to engage in construction in public ways;
3. rigorously enforce such standards and regulations; and
4. request Cambridge citizens to assist in reporting violations.
