Ordered,

That due notice be given that it is the intention of this Board to lay out a new street in Ward One, from Vassall Lane to Brattle Street, the same to be laid out from a point in Vassall Lane opposite the end of Warden Street, and a private street leading over lands of Charles C. Little and William G. Stearns by the Reservoir of the Cambridge Water Works: - thence to Fayweather Street, so called, and thence over said Fayweather Street and land formerly of William Wells, to Brattle Street; and that any and all persons interested in the question of said laying out may appear and be heard at the regular meeting of this Board to be holden on Wednesday, the first day of January next, at 10 o'clock, A. M.
