- WHEREAS: Reverend Mazzeo will become Minister in Residence at the United Methodist Church of Belmont upon his retirement, now therefore be it

Mazzeo for his unselfish dedication to both his congregation and to the City of Cambridge and to further extend to both Reverend and Mrs. Mazzeo our best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement, and be it further
