COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to notify the Cambridge Housing Authority that this City Council held a public hearing on December 17, 1984 to hear from Sandra Fowler of 43 Lincoln Way, who informed this City Council that she would be without a home or housing in the near future due to circumstances beyond her control, and that this City Council urges the Cambridge Housing Authority to investigate this case and further to do everything within their power to assist her in finding suitable housing for her family; and be it further

ORDERED: That this City Council desires that her present housing be kept intact until housing assistance is provided and that the ultimate goal of this City Council is for a final and complete solution of her housing problem; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Department of Human Services to coordinate this effort and to further consider alternate means of housing in both the public and private sector including Harvard College, and that one person from the Human Services Department be assigned and be responsible to follow this matter through to a final and successful conclusion.
