This is to advise you that pursuant to a communication from Francis Richter, Manager of Communications, requesting a public hearing before the Cambridge City Council, the Mayor has scheduled said public hearing for Monday, November 26, 1990 beginning at 7:00 P. M. The hearing will be held in the Sullivan Chamber, Second Floor, Cambridge City Hall, 795 Massachusetts Avenue and it is anticipated that you will discuss the on going problems with mail delivery in Cambridge along with providing them with an update on service improvements you mention in your communication to the Mayor dated October 11, 1990.

Although you indicated in that communication you would be attending the City Council meeting of October 29, 1990 you need to understand neither the Mayor nor I had set that date. The rules of the City Council require a set procedure which was outlined to Mr. Richter during a recent telephone conversation in which I had indicated the first possible date for such a hearing was October 29th since at the time of the conversation nothing had been scheduled. However, the Mayor has since scheduled another public hearing for that date.

I apologize for the confusion, but I'm sure you can appreciate it is rather busy in local government these days.
