The cost of street lighting under present conditions was \$147,875.50 for the year 1940, and

WHEREAS

To properly protect the safety and welfare of our citizens it is necessary to make several changes both in the type of lights used, as well as the installation of street lights at various new locations as recommended by the Committee on Wires and Lamps, and

WHEREAS

In order to make these changes which will be beneficial to the inhabitants of our city, the cost will be as follows:-

Improvements and new locations	\$ 2435
Huron Avenue Section	1245
Arc Lamp change overs	312

a total of \$ 3,992, thus bringing the cost of street lighting for the year 1941 to \$151, 367.50 now therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That, in addition to the amount already appropriated, His Honor, the Mayor, be and hereby is requested to appropriate the sum of \$11,867.50 to Electrical Department, Street Lighting so that this department may properly function for the safeguard and protection of the citizens of Cambridge.
