
WHEREAS:

ORDERED:


That under the provisions of Section 101 Chapter 32 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, there shall be paid to his widow, Mary A. Reardon, for as long as she remains unmarried, an annual allowance in the amount of twelve hundred dollars (\$1200.00)
