An Ordinance,  
relating to the Salary of the Treasurer and Collector.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the  
City of Cambridge, as follows:—

1. The Salary of the City Treasurer and  
Collector shall be seven hundred dollars per  
annum, payable quarterly, which shall be in  
full for his services, and all fees for summonses,  
warrants, and other services, received by him,  
shall be paid into the City Treasury.

2. All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances,  
inconsistent herewith, are hereby ~~and~~ repealed.
