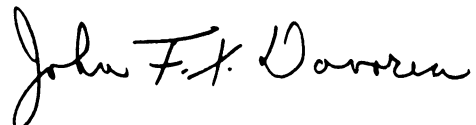

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

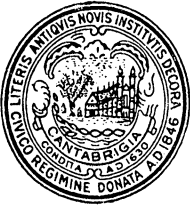

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a not-for-profit membership corporation under Chapter 180 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, certify:

1. NAME: The name of the proposed corporation, hereinafter called the Corporation, is Cambridge Christian Life Ministries, Incorporated.

2. PURPOSES: (a) The Corporation shall be a non-profit corporation. The purposes for which the Corporation is being created are to receive and administer funds for charitable, religious, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as it now exists or may hereafter be amended and to that end to take and hold by bequest, devise, gift, grant, purchase, lease, or otherwise any property, real, personal, tangible or intangible, without limitation as to amount or value, to sell, convey or otherwise dispose of any such property and to invest, reinvest, or deal with the principal or the income thereof in such manner as, in the judgement of the directors, will best promote the purposes of the Corporation without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received, these Articles of Incorporation, the By-laws of the Corporation, or any laws applicable thereto.

Pursuant to a communication from the Secretary of State re: "Cambridge Christian Life Ministries, Incorporated," I made an investigation. The locus is suitable.

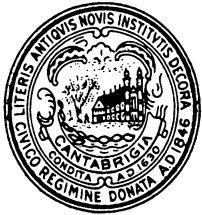

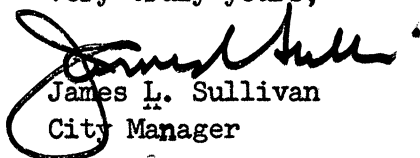
