While at City Council on March 29, 1994, I picked up the Committee Report from the March 22, 1994, meeting of the Public Service Committee regarding City parks and open space.

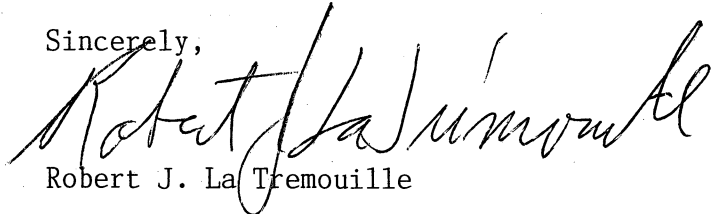

The one strong problem with Guffey Park is the fact that a promised trash can appeared, very promptly disappeared and stayed disappeared. Trash accumulates in the bushes and stays there for much too long a period.

Please include Guffey Park on your list of parks and open space. It is hoped as well that the clean-up problem will be corrected.
