To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$55,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Other Ordinary Maintenance Account from the Massachusetts' Office for School to Work Transition through Bunker Hill Community College. These funds will be used by the Office of Workforce Development to enhance emerging school-to-work initiatives in Cambridge and to plan and implement a year-round career pathways system through engaging local employers and providing marketing and recruitment materials. The programs will serve school aged youth from diverse backgrounds as well as low and moderate income groups. Funds will be used to subcontract with local non-profits and for coordination through the Office of Workforce Development.
