

# City of Cambridge.

In the year one thousand eight hundred  
and fifty six.

## An Ordinance,

In addition to "an Ordinance establishing  
a Fire Department and Providing for  
preventing and extinguishing Fire."

Be it ordained by the City Council  
of the City of Cambridge, as follows.

1. Back Engine Company, appointed  
by the Mayor and Aldermen, shall consist  
of forty men, and shall have a Foreman,  
First and Second Assistant Foreman,  
Clerk, and Steward, and these officers  
shall be chosen by ballot subject to  
the approval of the Board of Engineers  
and of the Mayor and Aldermen,  
and any person rejected shall not be  
returned the second time for approval.

2. Back Hook and Ladder  
Company appointed by the Mayor  
and Aldermen shall consist of twenty-  
five men, and shall have a Foreman,  
First and Second Foreman, Clerk and  
Steward, and these officers shall be  
chosen by ballot subject to the approval  
of the Board of Engineers, and of the  
Board of Mayor and Aldermen,  
and any person, rejected, shall not  
be returned the second time for approval.

3. The ninth and tenth sections  
of an Ordinance, relating to the

Fire Department, passed on  
the twenty-sixth day of December  
eighteen hundred and fifty four,  
shall be and the same are hereby  
repealed.
