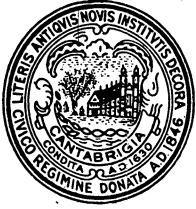

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

The purposes for which the corporation is to be formed are for cultural and educational, purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, and in this connection to specifically establish a non-profit, educational, technical institution in which individuals, regardless of their race, creed, color or sex, will be offered courses of instruction in the promotion of the art and profession of beauty and health culture. Such instruction shall include the regular conduct of classes, courses and lectures generally involving the use and application of all methods and means of every description and kind pertaining to the instruction and the promotion of the art and profession of beauty and health culture; and to do all other things and perform all other acts consistent with these purposes and allowed under Chapter 180 of the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as from time to time amended.

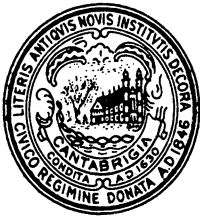

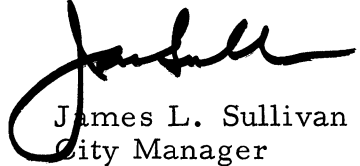
