WHEREAS:-

The Central School founded in 1968 and located at 264 Broadway, Cambridge, Mass. is a model school designed to encourage participation by parents in the educational process of the children and is dedicated to the improvement of the education of the children by allowing the children to enlarge their capacity by pursuing their own individual interests and to encourage the children to think for themselves with the help of student teachers recruited from Tufts, Harvard, Boston University and Wheelock, and

WHEREAS:-

The Central School is an integrated nursery-kindergarten offering educational opportunities to children between the ages of three to five and one-half and presently has thirty students and operates under an open structured program that is partly based on methods developed in the experimental schools of Leicestershire, England and offers children from different backgrounds varied opportunities to create, communicate and succeed, and

WHEREAS:-

Parents play an important roll in the operation of the schools and form the majority of the board of directors working together with the faculty in raising funds and hiring staff members and have received assistance from many private, charitable and educational agencies and conduct educational work shops that draw on the resources of the Boston area which are attended by public and private school teachers and concerned parents, therefore be it

RESOLVED:-

That the City Council go on record congratulating Mrs. Lisa Pershouse, Director of the Central School, the staff and faculty of the Central School for their endeavors to increase the educational opportunities of children in the City of Cambridge and their sponsors for their efforts to obtain the best possible education for these children of Cambridge.
