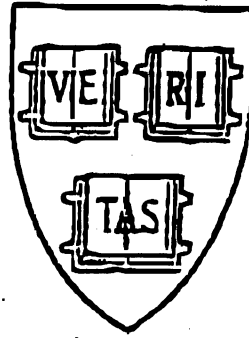

In this program, students spend a half of each school day working and learning on site at Harvard while receiving a paid stipend. Students also keep daily journals and attend a humanities seminar (for English and Social Studies credit) at the work site. Readings, writings and discussions revolve around issues of work.

The Harvard University Internship Program offers multi-craft positions for juniors and seniors in various departments at Harvard. The internship program offers two different kinds of work settings:

- If you are someone who thinks you might enjoy working in an office setting and are interested in computers and learning a variety of computer skills, you could be placed in one of Harvard's administrative offices.
- If you are someone who enjoys working with your hands and are looking for challenging and practical work experiences, you could be placed in the field and might find yourself working in a kitchen for Harvard Dining Services preparing food for catering and party events or you could be assisting a manager for one of Harvard's apartment complexes and learn the day to day skills needed to be a successful property manager.
