- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the Cambridge City Council that Passim will celebrate its 47th Anniversary in May, 2005; and
- WHEREAS: The three-day anniversary celebration is entitled "47 @ 47" in honor of Passim's genesis as Club 47, one of the most influential clubs of its kind during the 1960's folk phenomenon; and
- WHEREAS: Many legendary artists started at Club 47 and Passim before going on to play larger venues, including Joan Baez, Bob Dylan, Tom Rush, Jimmy Buffet, Taj Mahal and Patty Larkin; and
- WHEREAS: The celebration will feature a retrospective concert on Thursday, May 19th, hosted by Tom Rush, The Second Lively Legends concert on Friday, May 20th, hosted by Jim Rooney and Robert L. Jones of the Newport Folk Festival; both these events will benefit Passim and its programs, Culture for Kids and the Passim School of Music; and
- WHEREAS: On Friday, May 21, 2005, to thank the community for its support, Passim and the Cambridge Arts Council will co-sponsor a free music festival on the Cambridge Common. The concert will begin at 11:00 a.m. with a children's performance and continue with performances from well-known performers, including the Resophonics, Jim Kwestin, Sarah Borges and The Loomers; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record extending its congratulations to Club Passim on their 47th Anniversary with a three day celebration, concerts on May 19 and 20 at the Sanders Theatre at 7:00 p.m., and on May 21 at a free music festival on the Cambridge Common at 11:00 a.m.; and be it further
