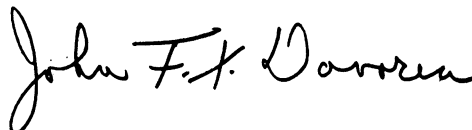

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

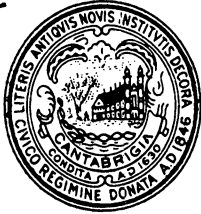

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

In order to carry out the provisions of its charter, the general purposes and functions of the Coordinating Committee shall be:

To plan, organize, coordinate and review treatment programs for persons with drug-related problems; to develop, conduct, administer and coordinate such programs individually and together with other organizations, corporations and foundations and state or federal agencies and departments, exclusively for educational and charitable purposes; and to be the responsible agency for channeling funds to participating programs under a Drug Abuse Services Project Grant of the National Institute of Mental Health.

To do and engage in any and all lawful activities that may be incidental or reasonably necessary to any of the foregoing purposes, and to have and exercise all other powers and authority now or hereafter conferred upon corporations under Chapter 180 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

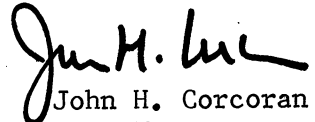
