Petition of Boston Edison Company for approval by the Department of Public Utilities of the Company's entering into, execution and delivery of a Credit Agreement and a Note and Security Agreement by and among the Company, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, and The First National Bank of Boston providing for (1) the formation of a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company (2) the guaranty by the Company of all obligations of said subsidiary or BECO Fuel Company, Inc. in connection with the issuance by said subsidiary or BECO Fuel Company, Inc. of commercial paper not in excess of \$50,000,000; and (3) the incurring of indebtedness by the Company; and for the grant of exemption from the competitive bidding requirements of Chapter 164 of the General Laws; the proceeds of such borrowings to be used for the Company's general corporate purposes, including expenditures for nuclear material and capital expenditures.

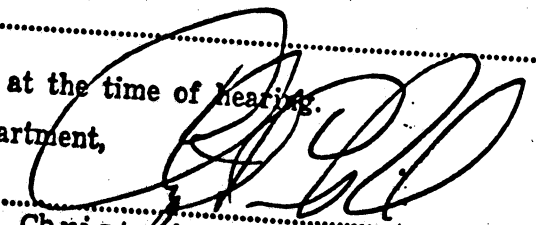
