February 22, 1982

- WHEREAS: A list of registrants for the draft is posted at Cambridge City Hall; and
- WHEREAS: According to the Military Selective Service Act of 1948 (c625, 62 STAT. 604), Section 6, subsection h, the posting of said list is required at draft boards and nowhere else; and
- WHEREAS: Registration and the draft only increase the possibility of war, at a time when it is of the utmost importance to focus our resources on the needs of our own citizens; and
- WHEREAS: The people of Cambridge have already, in a recent referendum, made it clear that they do not favor an increased role of the military at the expense of important services in cities such as Cambridge; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the City Solicitor to remove, until further notice, said list from public access.
