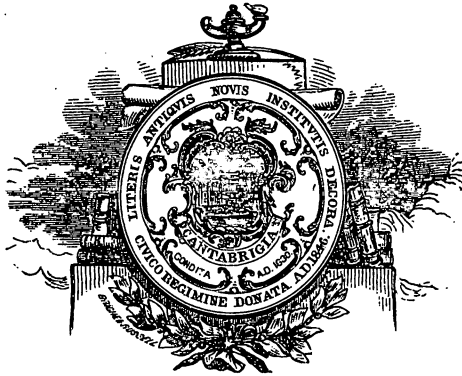


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Mayor and Aldermen, Nov. 11, 1863.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that *Alleston Street*, so called, should be *extended from its present north westerly terminus to its original* *Street* and should be *laid out* as a public highway,

it is therefore hereby Ordered, that due notice be given to *William H. Allen, Henry F. Adams, Joseph May, and Nicholas Saffy,* and any and all other persons interested

that this Board intends to *extend and lay out* the Street before mentioned, by taking a portion of *this* land and laying out the same as a public street—and that *Wednesday, the twenty-fifth day of November current at 8 o'clock, P. M.,* is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
