That, on the petition of Massachusetts Institute of Technology, that they be granted permission to connect their property at the rear of No. 428 Memorial Drive with the common sewers in Amherst Alley and Vassar Street provided that they first pay into the City Treasury the usual sewer assessment amounting in this case to five thousand one hundred ten dollars (\$5110.00). And it is further

That, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 80 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, as amended by Chapter 63 of the Acts of 1933, the aforesaid assessment is hereby certified to the Board of Assessors.
