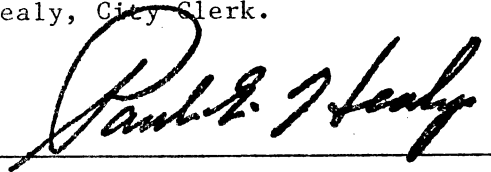
COUNCILLOR DUEHAY
