To the Honorable, the City Council:

Enclosed per your request is a list of Constables with Power currently authorized in the City of Cambridge.

They are eighty in number and more than 25% of them are City employees who require this authority as part of their employment.

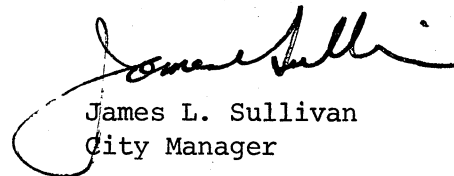
There is no list for the 116 Constables without Power since the majority of these are security guards at various local institutions and stores. The turnover is great in the 'without power' category and a listing would be of no value.

With respect to the process involved, this office refers requests to the City Solicitor who in turn has a records and background check done by the Criminal Investigation Division of the Police Department, who forwards the report back to the Solicitor for his recommendations to the Manager as provided for in Chapter 41, Section 91B.

With respect to limiting the number of Constables with Power, the statutes are silent on a restriction in Cities while towns may appoint as many as are deemed necessary.

Should the City Council desire to set a policy of a ceiling on the number of Constables, I feel that it would be valid.
