Chap. 5. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF
BANKS TO CAUSE CERTAIN RECORDS OF LIQ-
UIDATED BANKS IN HIS POSSESSION TO BE
DESTROYED.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-five A of chapter one hundred and sixty-seven of the General Laws, the commissioner of banks is hereby authorized to destroy or otherwise dispose of the records of liquidated banks presently stored at 1416 Hingham street in the city of Cambridge; provided, however, that such records stored at such location subsequent to December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and fifty shall not be disposed of or so destroyed.
