WHEREAS: It has recently come into question whether or not a fair and reasonable percentage of present city employees are Cambridge residents; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council request the City Manager to obtain specific information as to the current percentage of city employees who are Cambridge residents, and report back to the City Council in two weeks.
