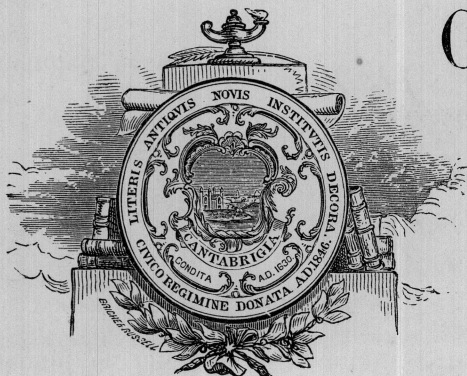

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the
removal of all fences or other obstructions
standing thereon
