WHEREAS: In the construction of the MBTA Redline to the Alewife area, residents of North Cambridge were guaranteed permanent access to the East Head House and a fully operational police substation; and

WHEREAS: Actions by the MBTA management have been contrary to such guarantees by closing the access leaving it prone to vandalism and causing a visual blight; and

WHEREAS: These actions have led to the creation of a dangerous situation for area residents and "T" commuters; and

WHEREAS: Crime in the Alewife area has risen significantly in the first quarter of 1991; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to arrange and attend a meeting between members of this City Council, the "T" Advisory Committee, area residents and appropriate "T" officials to discuss the re-opening of the East Head House and the staffing of a police substation.
