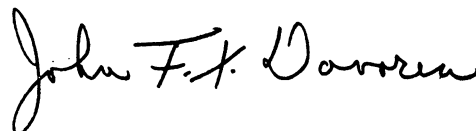

Continued: Articles of Organization, The National Jewish Theatre, Inc.
Paragraph 4.

No compensation or payment shall ever be paid or made to any member, officer, director, trustee, creator, or organizer of this corporation, or substantial contributor to it, except as a reasonable allowance for actual expenditures or services actually made or rendered to or for this corporation; and neither the whole nor any part or portion of the assets or net earnings, current or accumulated, of this corporation shall ever be distributed to or divided among any such person; provided, further, that neither the whole nor any part or portion of such assets or net earnings shall ever be used for, accrue to, or inure to the benefit of any member or private individual within the meaning of IRC Sec. 501(c)(3).

In the event of termination, dissolution or winding up of this corporation in any manner or for any reason whatsoever, its remaining assets, if any, shall be distributed to (and only to) one or more organizations described in IRC Sec. 501(c)(3).

Subject to the foregoing provisions, the powers and purposes of this corporation shall at all times be so construed and limited as to enable this corporation to qualify as a foundation organized and existing under Chapter 180, Massachusetts General Laws.

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

To encourage and promote Jewish culture and knowledge through the production of and participation in performances for live theatre, film, radio, television, recordings and other media, and by the organization, promotion and conducting of classes, workshops, exhibitions and other theatrical activities, exclusively within the charitable, educational and literary purposes allowed under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

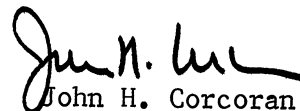
