WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council of the quick and heroic efforts of two on-duty Cambridge Police Officers in saving the life of a retired Police Officer; and

WHEREAS: On Wednesday, August 31, 1994 James Finn collapsed on the pitchers mound at Hoyt Field during a playoff game between Freddie Mac's and the Giants; and

WHEREAS: Officers David Fimiani and John Callinan applied CPR techniques, learned through yearly training sessions, in trying to regain a pulse; and

WHEREAS: This life-saving technique needed to be applied twice by the officers and again by Emergency Medical Technicians before Officer Finn was transported to the hospital; and

WHEREAS: Through the officers' actions, the fire rescue operation and Professional Ambulance Officer Finn is now in critical but stable condition; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record commending Officers David Fimiani and John Callinan for their heroic actions in the saving of a life; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to transmit suitably engrossed copies of this resolution to the Police Commissioner for inclusion in the Officers' Personnel file.
