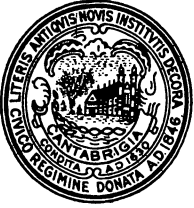

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$100.00 to reimburse Robert B. O'Neill, Jr., an employee of the Police Department for damages in this amount.

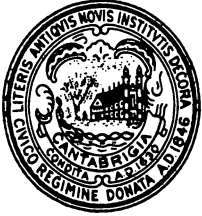


