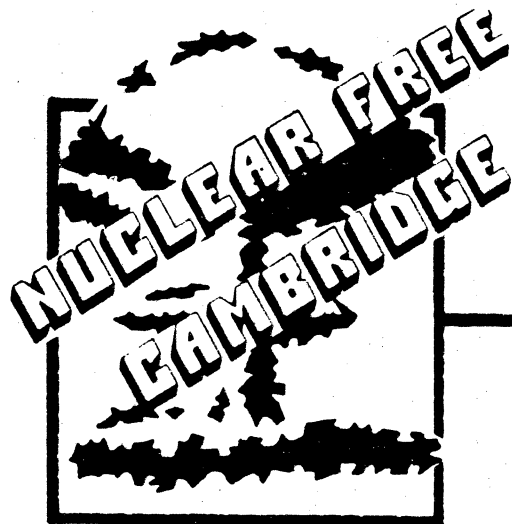

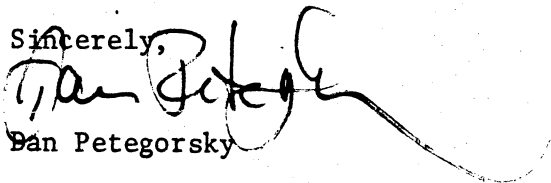

Dear Councilors,

Due to the recent Council action failing to place the Nuclear Free Cambridge Act on the November Cambridge ballot, we have been forced to seek redress from the Massachusetts Supreme Judiciary Court. As you are no doubt aware, we will be heard September 13, 1983 (the Tuesday following your meeting).

While the City Solicitor's office is preparing no defense of the Council's action, we feel it is important to remind you that an SJC reversal of the unexplained action will be embarrassing and could be very costly for the city. The SJC will rule not only on our ballot status, but also on whether we should be awarded legal costs (approximately \$20,000). We as much as you hope to avoid this expenditure of taxpayer's money, and so we urge you to place this question on the November ballot at your September 12 meeting.
