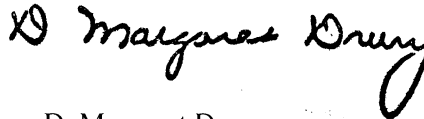


- WHEREAS: Past National Commander John P. Comer will serve as Installing Officer for the ceremony; now therefore be it
