NOW, THEREFORE, THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION is such that if the above bounden Principal shall, for the indefinite term beginning the 22nd day of March, 19 76, faithfully perform the duties of his said office and properly account for all moneys and property received by virtue thereof, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that this obligation may be terminated upon the date specified in a written notice from the Obligee to the Surety, such date to be not prior to thirty (30) days before receipt of such notice by the Surety, or upon the date specified in a written notice from the Surety to the Obligee, such date to be not less than thirty (30) days after mailing of such notice to the Obligee. This obligation shall be deemed canceled as to any act or acts occurring on or after the effective date specified in such notice given by the Obligee or Surety.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH,

That the aforesaid

Peter Parise

having been appointed by the City Manager of the City of Cambridge one of the Constables within the said City, for the term ending ^{three} ~~one~~ year from the first Monday in January, 19 **76**, and until another be appointed in his place, now if said **Peter Parise** shall faithfully exercise all the powers and perform all the duties entrusted to and imposed upon him by the laws of the Commonwealth and the ordinances of the City of Cambridge; shall carefully intend the preservation of the peace, the discovery and prevention of all attempts against the same; shall duly execute all warrants which shall be sent unto him from lawful authority, and faithfully attend to all such directions in the laws and orders of Court, as are or shall be committed to his care; shall comply with the orders and directions of the City Manager and Council, which shall be passed from time to time for the regulation of the Constables; shall faithfully and with what speed he can, collect and levy all such fines, distresses, rates, assessments, and sums of money for which he shall have sufficient warrants according to law, rendering an account thereof, and paying the same according to the direction in his warrant; and also, if he shall faithfully perform all the duties of a Constable in the service of all civil processes which may be committed to him, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect.
